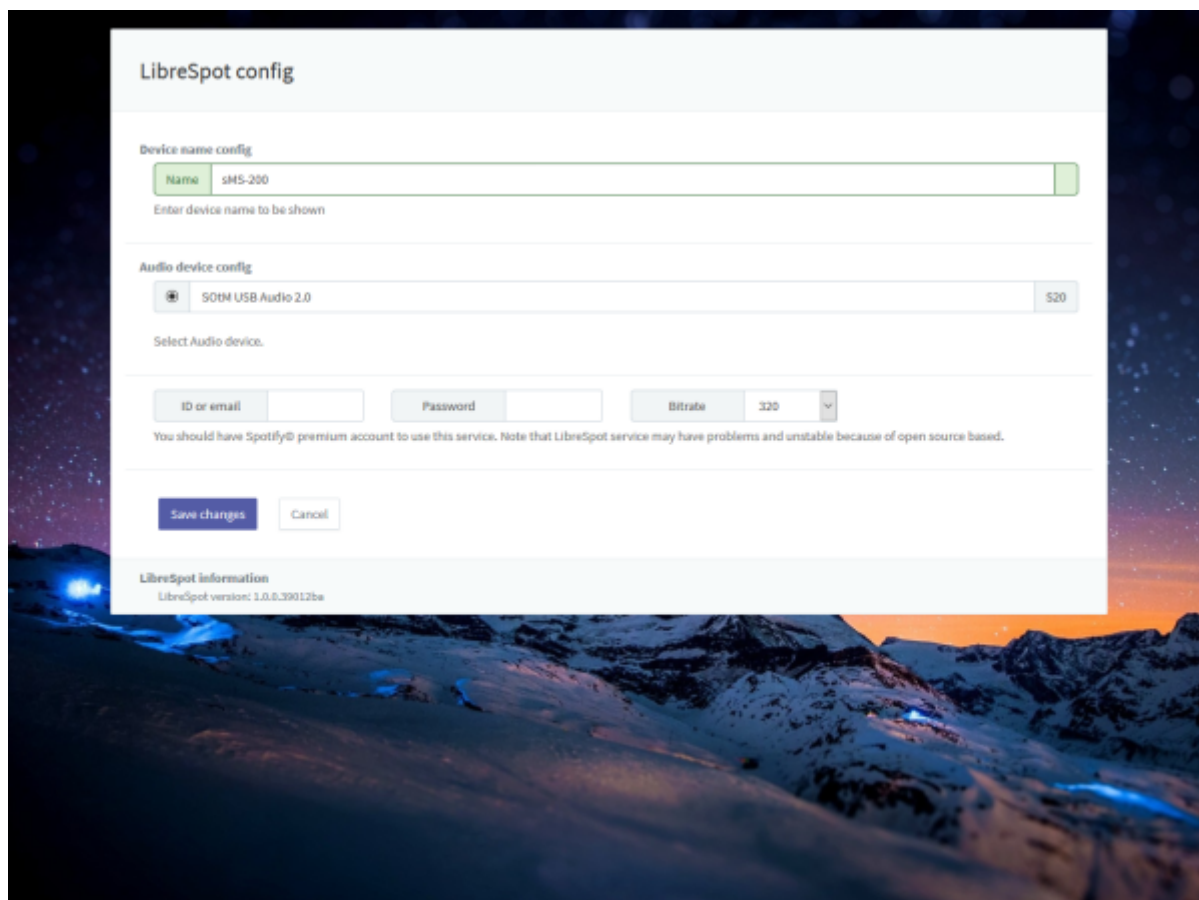


# LibreSpot

LibreSpot is a open source implementation for Spotify-connect® which is served from Spotify®.
